All information and dates are subject to change

Phase 9 – Modified (September 17, 2022 – September 30, 2023)

FALL 2022

- Volunteers and participants are expected to
 - **Not** attend 4-H meetings, events, or programs if they have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 5 days
 - **Not** attend 4-H meetings, events, or programs if they have COVID-19-like symptoms
 - Wear a face mask when around others for 10 days after quarantine or isolation
 - Sanitize common surfaces and shared equipment
- Face masks are no longer required on UH campuses and properties
 - Individuals may continue to wear masks and others should be respectful of others' masking preferences
 - Campus officials may further specify areas where face masks are required to enhance safety
- Any additional COVID-19 restrictions or guidelines required by the county or state and/or facility where the meeting/program/event is being held must be followed
- Virtual events (meetings, events, and programs) can be held with no COVID-19 restrictions
