The 4-H approved teen volunteers (14-19 years old) will be able to partner with the trained adult volunteer leaders to run the program. Participants must attend **ALL 12 hours** of instruction to be certified as 4-H Shooting Sports Level 1 instructor. **NOTE:** Participants must also be approved 4-H volunteer leader prior to attending a 4-H Shooting Sports Certification Workshop. COVID guidelines may subject to change depending on changes in state and county guidelines.
