## AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

*Note*: All participants will receive an individual recognition award for participating. Participants who submit forms by the deadline will be eligible for Top of the Show (see descriptions below).

- Individual All Juniors, Intermediate and Seniors will receive either a blue, red or white ribbon and be judged according to the Danish Awards System for participating. All participants will be judged against a standard (blue, red and white standards) rather than against each other. Thus, it is possible to have all blue winners (the highest award) if all contestants reach the blue standard. On the other hand, it is also possible to have only red and white award winners. All Cloverbuds are a non-competitive division and will receive three written positive remarks and a green participatory ribbon.
- **First Time** All first-time participants in the Communications Fair will be recognized. Please indicate on the form if youth is a first-time participant.
- **Top of the Show** Top scores for each contest will be awarded "Top of the Show" with a purple ribbon and a prize. Only for those in Junior, Intermediate and Senior Division.
