Code of Conduct

The purpose of the Hawaii 4-H Code of Conduct is to ensure the safety, well-being, and positive learning environment
for all participants at 4-H sponsored events and activities. It applies to all participants, with participants defined as 4-H
members, their parents/guardians, and volunteers.

As a participant in the 4-H program, I will:

- 1. **Respect Rules** Respect and adhere to the rules and guidelines of the 4-H program including those specific to any 4-H event or activity, in which I am involved.
- 2. **Respect Others** Conduct myself in a courteous manner and treat members, parents, 4-H volunteers, Extension staff, judges and others with respect. Appropriate language and behavior are expected at all times.
- 3. **Respect Extension Staff and Volunteers** Accept supervision and support from county and state 4-H staff while participating in the 4-H program. This includes acceptance of supervision and support from 4-H volunteers coordinating 4-H events and activities.
- 4. **Respect the 4-H Program -** Abstain from illegal behaviors, use of alcohol, marijuana, illegal or illicit drugs, and tobacco including e-cigarettes and vaping device during 4-H events and activities.

All aspects of the 4-H Code of Conduct also apply to individual social media presence involving 4-H.

I understand if I fail to adhere to the above Code of Conduct, I can be subject to disciplinary action and/or potentially prohibited from attending and participating in the Hawaii 4-H Youth Development Program.
