Caron became a Teen 4-H leader of a Cloverbuds 4-H Club when she was in the 8th grade. She was an annual volunteer in the kindergarten readiness KAMP program. In 1996, Caron attended the National 4-H Congress and was selected to serve on the National 4-H Design Team to assist in planning for the 1997 National 4-H Congress. (One of five 4-Hers selected nationwide.)

Caron received a four year scholarship to the University of Hawaii. After receiving her B.S. degree in Business, she continued her education at the University of Denver Law School where she received her law degree and also a Master's Degree in Tax Law.

Returning to Hawaii, Caron worked for the State Probate Court, Damon Key Law Firm, and finally the Bank of Hawaii where she was the Vice President and Manager of the Trust Services Group, Financial Management Department.
