EMPLOYEES

Wash your hands:

before

work

handling produce

touching food contact surfaces

after

breaks

using the toilet

touching unsanitary surfaces

Do not eat, drink, smoke, or chew gum or tobacco in food production areas.

Do not wear jewelry in food production areas.

Report all injuries to your supervisor.

Report suspicious activities and safety concerns to your supervisor.

Wear clean clothing in packaging or processing areas.

Do not handle fresh produce, touch food contact surfaces or packaging, if you are sick, nauseous, or have diarrhea.









Follow all posted signs and notices.

Do not handle produce or touch any production equipment while visiting.

Do not eat, drink, smoke, or chew gum or tobacco in food production areas.

Do not wear jewelry in food production areas.

Report all injuries to a company representative.

Wear company supplied safety equipment as instructed.









NO TRESPASSING

All visitors must report to office.

Employees are required to report all suspicious activities.










DISCARD POLICY

All produce that comes in contact with an unsanitary surface, such as the floor, must be discarded.

All produce that comes in contact with blood or other bodily fluids must be discarded.











NO eating, drinking, smoking, or chewing gum or tobacco in the food production areas.










Hawaii Law States:

Do not use raw human waste as a fertilizer for vegetables.

Do not sell vegetables washed with non-potable water.

Do not sell vegetables ordinarily eaten raw (such as watercress or lettuce) that are grown in areas where contamination can occur from irrigation water or from animals.
