Qualifications:

- Classified degree-seeking student in the MA or PhD program in East Asian Languages & Literatures
- Be in good academic standing and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above
- Maintain 6 credits per semester except for those who are taking EALL 800 or 700
- TOEFL scores of 600/100 (paper/Internet) or above, with subtest scores of 25 for listening and 25 for speaking, or IELTS score of 7.0 or above for the overall band test results

Required Documentation (attach with applications):

- 3 letters of recommendation
- CV
- Transcripts from all previous colleges and universities (copies are acceptable)
- Chinese Applicants: submit an mp3 recording that contains (1) a self-introduction in Mandarin Chinese; (2) a conversation in Mandarin Chinese with a/another native speaker of it, preferably a person of the opposite gender (yourself in the dialogue so that we know which of the two is you); and (3) a self-introduction in English. (Maximum recording time: 15 minutes)
- Japanese Applicants: For language GA positions, submit proof of high-level proficiency in Japanese (i.e., OPI rating, Japanese Language Placement Test)
