Here is Hawai'i's finest in mele! His collection of nearly 1000 translated Hawaiian songs are currently housed in the Bishop Museum. He is the collector, editor and translator of the internationally acclaimed Puke Mele: A Book of Hawaiian Songs. He is the kumu hula of The Lei Hulu Hula School, the leader of the distinguished Hawaiian musical group Lei Hulu and a recording artist of three albums; Cha-lang-a-lang, Lei Hulu Sings for the Hula and his most recent release Hula Lives for which he has won two Nā Hoku Hanohano Awards. He has been a judge for the famed Merrie Monarch Hula Competition, the Queen Liliuokalani Keiki Hula Competition as well as the Kamehameha Song Contest. He is highly sought after for his knowledge in mele and hula by hula teachers all over Hawai'i nei and around the world. He is currently the Hawaiian Language Professor at the Honolulu Community College. This summer we are blessed to have this wonderful scholar back again for HAW 483 Papa Mele Wahi Pana, Nā Hono A'o Pi'ilani, a course that will focus on songs composed for the island of Maui, Lāna'i, Kaho'olawe and Moloka'i.
