### MELE PROJECTS

#### -Nā Mele o Hawai‘i Nei

Nā Mele O Hawai‘i Nei focuses on the digitization of mele from vintage vinyl recordings that feature revered mele practitioners, who, for the most part were native speakers or trained by those who were learned in the art of mele performance. These include 45, 78 & 33 1/3 rpm recordings from the Kimo Alama Keaulana Collection, House of Music Collection, the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa Sinclair Library Vinyl Collection, Bishop Museum Audio Disc Collection, R. Keawe Lopes, Jr. Collection, Hernandez Collection, and the Mayer Collection. To date, KWAKA cares for 13,398 mele recordings.

#### -Ke Welo Mau Nei

Ke Welo Mau Nei is a guest lecture series featuring revered mele practitioners, sponsored in collaboration with Kawaihuelani Center for Hawaiian Language’s mele courses. To date, KWAKA has organized 18 series and welcomed 99 guest lectures. The digital collection of these guest lecture series account for 106 hours of video footage that include a variety of personal mo‘olelo told by the mele practitioners themselves.

#### -Lā Mele

The mission of Lā Mele is to bring those of both the community and the academy together to celebrate mele and mele practitioners. Lā Mele features intellectual and engaging sessions on the topic of mele including: Mele Panel Discussions, Mele Performances, Mele sing-a-long sessions and a Mele Choral Competition featuring Hawaiian Immersion and Charter Schools. To date, KWAKA has documented six Lā Mele Series, 24 Guest Lecture Performers, 22 school choir participants and 24 hours of video documentation.

#### -Ka Papa Mele Kauwela

In the Winter of 2002, KWAKA created a Summer Hawaiian language mele course taught by revered scholar of mele, Associate Professor Kimo Alama Keaulana. As a result, Hawaiian 483, Ka Papa Mele Wahi Pana was developed for students of both the academy and the community to learn mele composed specifically for pana ‘āina, KWAKA offered Ka Papa Mele Wahi Pana for six consecutive Summers, Summer 2003 – Summer 2008, and, in 2011, KWAKA offered Ka Papa Mele Inoa or name songs. KWAKA stewards over 598 mele from Keaulana’s personal collection and 206 hours of video documentation of Keaulana teaching and sharing mo‘olelo about them.

#### -Ho‘okani Mānoa

In the Fall semester of 2002, Ho‘okani Mānoa was created as a venue to showcase the traditional musical stylings of mele practitioners. Ho‘okani Mānoa consisted of two very unique programs: Ho‘okani Mānoa Reminisces and Ho‘okani Mānoa Continues. Currently, KWAKA cares for 101 hours of video documentation that feature 110 musical groups.
