

Mānoa International Exchange (MIX)

Mānoa International Exchange is one of the many ways the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa's commitment to international education and understanding is demonstrated. Various academic units on the UHM campus, with the assistance of the UHM International Exchange Coordinator, maintain and support international exchange agreements with universities around the world.

Mānoa International Exchange provides an opportunity for UHM undergraduate and graduate students to study overseas and also allows students from our overseas partner universities to study at UHM. An exchange may be for one or two semesters. Some of the exchange agreements are for students with specific majors, but most are open to any student. Participants are registered as full-time students at their home university while on exchange, pay their normal tuition to the home university and do not pay tuition at the host university. They are, however, responsible for travel costs, flight arrangements, housing and meals. The host university provides information on housing options.

A student exchange agreement with an overseas university can be proposed by any of the academic units on the UHM campus. Exchange agreements are always based on reciprocity, so the UHM academic unit must confirm that UHM students are willing to go abroad and that these students will benefit from the exchange.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the requirements to be an exchange student?

An exchange student should have sophomore standing or higher; the minimum GPA requirement ranges from 2.5 to 3.0.

What are the application deadlines?

For students coming to UHM, the application deadline is April 1 for the Fall semester and September 15 for the Spring semester. For UHM students going overseas, the application deadline for most schools is March 1 for the Fall semester. But some schools in Japan have earlier deadlines, so plan ahead and contact the International Exchange Coordinator for more information.

Do exchange students get transfer credit?

Yes. After an exchange student completes his/her program of study, the host institution will send a transcript to the home institution. The home institution then applies the appropriate transfer credit. Exchange students should discuss with their academic advisor and exchange coordinator the classes they plan to take at the host institution *before* going overseas.
