1 Endnote (WASC's definitions on Distance Education, Off-campus, and Blended programs)

Distance Education: 50% or more of the program is offered via satellite, internet, or any other kind of technology-assisted medium. WASC identifies programs that meet this definition as "**Online**" programs.

Off-Campus: 50% or more of the program is offered at a location more than 25 miles from the home campus. [NOTE: these are programs where 50% or more of the program is conducted at "**remote**" locations and delivered by instructors who physically travel to those locations to deliver the program.]

Blended: 50% or more of the program is offered using a combination of off-campus and/or distance education.
