Notes:

- Must audition at least one piece of original choreography for concert performance as a prerequisite to the senior project by sixth semester of study.
- DNCE 151, 361, and 362 are only offered every other year. See dance advisor for more information about class offerings.
- DNCE 3X1/4X1 signify ballet or modern dance.
- Students must incorporate all focus requirements into this plan.
- Minimum 45 upper division (300+ course) credits are required.
