PRAXIS II components required for licensure in Hawai'i and must be passed to proceed to the teaching residencies (KRS 405-406).

Teacher candidates must hold current First Aid and CPR (Adult, Infant, and Child) certification; and current CESA membership are required for (KRS 402-404). KRS 402 and 404 must be taken concurrently.

KRS 405 and 406 require a minimum grade of B or better. Elementary and/or secondary residencies must be successfully completed for certification and licensure.
