SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

Aloha! You have already received a letter from the College of Education regarding your acceptance into the post-baccalaureate program in Math/Science. You are encouraged to apply for a special scholarship. This scholarship (up to \$9,000) will be awarded for the duration of the cohort.

The number of scholarships is limited, so apply right away.

Eligibility: To receive this scholarship, you must be:

- 1) enrolled in the program;
- 2) a U.S. citizen or resident alien; and
- 3) in good academic standing and maintain progress in the program.

Service Requirement: You must teach in a high-need* school in Hawai'i for at least the equivalent number of semesters in which you received the scholarship.

*For this scholarship, the term "high-need" is defined by the U.S. Department of Education's Scholarship Terms and Conditions, Authority 20 U.S.C. 1024(e), OMD Control #1840-0753.

Instructions: Applications must include all components listed below. Staple the components in the order they are listed. Only complete applications received by the deadline will be considered.

Scholarship Checklist:

- Complete the Personal Information and Agreement Form.** Be sure to complete the Personal Information section, read and understand the Agreement Section, and sign and date the form.
- Write a personal statement** that addresses, in order, each of the following:
 - 1) Your previous experience working with middle/high school students (maximum 100 words);
 - 2) Your career plans (maximum 100 words);
 - 3) Your commitment to teaching (maximum 150 words);
 - 4) How you can contribute to a high-need* school (maximum 150 words); and
 - 5) Three references--academic, professional, and personal--and their contact information.
- Copy the completed form and personal statement** for your records.
- Submit the original form and personal statement.**
