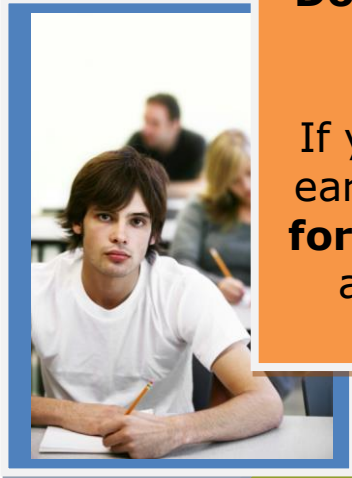


Want to get a head start?

Do you know a language other than English?

If yes, did you know that you can earn **3-16 FREE BACK-CREDITS for any single second language** at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa?



This is how it works:

Let's say you know Japanese by having studied the language in high school or speaking it at home. You'll take a Japanese placement test from the Japanese department. If you are placed in Japanese 202 (the fourth semester of Japanese), upon the completion of the course with a letter grade of 'C' or above, you may apply for additional 12 back-credits (the credits for the courses you are exempted from; JPN101, 102, and 201) at no cost.

At UH-Mānoa, you can study and get back-credits in any of the following languages.

Arabic, Cambodian, Chamorro, Chinese, Filipino, French, German, Greek, Hawaiian, Hindi, Ilokano, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Latin, Maori, Portuguese, Russian, Samoan, Spanish, Tahitian, Thai, Tongan, Vietnamese

Important: Restrictions apply. Students should read and understand the back credit policy before petitioning or taking a course. The policy is available at:
