March 1, 2025 to February 28, 2026

- 3. Budget
- 4. Invitation letter, conference acceptance letter or conference announcement (for request for travel funding)
- 5. Recommendation letter from advisor (students) or Chair (faculty)

#### **Deadline**

Jan 10, 2025 5:00 pm

#### About the decision

The CCS Scholarship Committee will review all the applications after the deadline. The scoring rubrics include the quality of the statement, impact of the expected outcomes, detailing of the budget, and strength of the recommendation letter. Preference will be given to junior faculty, graduate students, and first-time applicants. The decision letter will be sent out to all the applicants around mid-February, 2025.


