Aloha PhD and Master's Degree Candidates,

Congratulations as you have reached the final stages of your graduation! I am reaching out to all of you about an issue with the thesis/dissertation margins that we have just learned about. If you choose to order hard (printed) copies through ProQuest, please note that the margins of your thesis or dissertation should be adjusted and this will NOT affect your ability to graduate from UHM.

ProQuest *just* updated our University regarding the margin requirements for dissertations and theses. Due to printing of the pages front and back, the margins have changed from **1.5** inches on the left to **1** inch all around the entire manuscript. The content on all pages, including the page number, must fall WITHIN the margins specified and that the page number should be at the bottom center.

I understand that formatting may take a little more time during these final stages of your journey, but if you are ordering hard copies of your dissertations or theses and want to ensure that the page numbers are completely visible, please resubmit a re-formatted CD into our Graduate Student Services Office no later than Friday, September 1, 2014. **This is optional (only if you are going to order hard copies)**. Please note that once CDs are submitted to ProQuest, they cannot be changed or replaced in any way.
