 - All graduate students: *full-time = 8 cr (unless approved for 1 cr 700F or 800)
 - * (if full-time is required)

Reminders: GAs

- ► GA Letter of Offer: Provided to <u>ALL</u> GAs, including renewals
 - Per policy, letter to be signed by Dean or Director, at minimum
- Enrollment Requirement: 6 cr minimum (unless approved for 1 cr of 700F or 800)
- Good Academic Standing GPA and Appropriate progress
- GAs Working Out of State approval required by Provost
 - Process memo from GA supervisor via Graduate chair via school/college Dean via Graduate Division Dean to Provost Bruno
 - For longer than 1 month

Knowledge and Understanding

- 1. Demonstrate comprehensive knowledge in one or more general subject areas related to, but not confined to, a specific area of interest.
- 2. Demonstrate understanding of research methodology and techniques specific to one's field of study.

Intellectual and Applied Skills

- 3. Apply research methodology and/or scholarly inquiry techniques specific to one's field of study.
- 4. Critically analyze, synthesize, and utilize information and data related to one's field of study.

Communication Skills

- 5. Proficiently communicate and disseminate information in a manner relevant to the field and intended audience.
- Professional Responsibility
 - 6. Conduct research or projects as a responsible and ethical professional, including consideration of and respect for other cultural perspectives.
 - 7. Interact professionally with others.

Reminders: Advanced Degree ILOs (cont'd)

- ► Align with Program Learning Objectives
 - 1:1 alignment PLO to ILO
- ► Align and assess degree and program/course requirements
 - If not yet started, start collecting data to ensure students are meeting the ILOs
- ► Share and collaborate with your program faculty on ways to assess/evaluate these objectives

Considerations: For Current Students, Prospects, & Visitors


- ► Everyone is an ambassador for UHM and your graduate program

 - Program sheet with all degree/program requirements


Graduate Student Mentoring - What is the culture in your program?


- ▶ Is there a shared perspective on mentoring?

 - Graduate Faculty Do's and Don'ts






















ENROLLMENT: INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS DOCTORAL AND MASTER'S


