

Reminders: Advanced Degree ILOs

Knowledge and Understanding

- 1. Demonstrate comprehensive knowledge in one or more general subject areas related to, but not confined to, a specific area of interest.
 - 2. Demonstrate understanding of research methodology and techniques specific to one's field of study.

Intellectual and Applied Skills

- 3. Apply research methodology and/or scholarly inquiry techniques specific to one's field of study.
 - 4. Critically analyze, synthesize, and utilize information and data related to one's field of study.

Communication Skills

5. Proficiently communicate and disseminate information in a manner relevant to the field and intended audience.

Professional Responsibility

- 6. Conduct research or projects as a responsible and ethical professional, including consideration of and respect for other cultural perspectives.
 7. Interact professionally with others.

Reminders: Advanced Degree ILOs (cont'd)

- Align with Program Learning Objectives
- Align and assess degree and program/course requirements

 Share and collaborate with your program faculty on ways to assess/evaluate these objectives

Considerations: For Current Students, Prospects, & Visitors

- Everyone is an ambassador for UHM and your graduate program
 - Responsiveness to inquiries/questions is highly important for all graduate faculty
 - Students' decisions are influenced by interaction with graduate chair/faculty
- Ensure program website is fully functional
 - Up-to-date, accurate, informative, ADA compliant, and appealing
- Clear program and degree requirements are helpful to all
 - Program sheet with all degree/program requirements


Considerations: Graduate Student Mentoring – What is the culture in your program?

 - Graduate Faculty Do's and Don'ts




Enrollment Trends – All Graduate Students




Enrollment Trends – Doctoral & Master's Students (source MIRO)




Enrollment Trends – Graduate Certificates




Enrollment Trends – International Graduate Students









Graduation Patterns


Master's Degrees Awarded Spring & Summer 2017-2021 (source MIRO)




Master's Degrees: Time to Degree
