- New Liaison Graduate Admissions Application in use
 - Program materials verification of supplemental application materials survey due <u>12.15.2023</u>
 - Outcomes development to start March 2024; projected launch August 2025
 - Training for all faculty and staff: projected AY 24-25
- Graduate certificates UH to issue official certificate effective spring 2024
 - Submit Graduate Application; no fee to be charged for GCERT completers
- Graduate Assistantships
 - Current minimum required step = Step 12
 - Revision to salary schedule is in progress + revision to EP 5.223
 - For any 0.25FTE GA consideration, approval from Graduate Division is required first

 - Pending Form 2 students should be registered in 699 while waiting
- Course scheduling: note online credit limits (49% or less) if program is not approved as an online program


Combined Pathway (BAM) guidelines






National Acceptance Rates and Enrollment FT/PT







2022 CGS/GRE Survey of Graduate Enrollment and Degrees


Enrollment by Race









UHM US and International Graduate Enrollment: Fall 2018-2022




Enrollment trends – Graduate Certificates



Enrollment by Location: Fall 2023




WRGP Enrollment Trends
