## Jerry H. Bentley Scholarship in World History

Academic Year 2021-22

This scholarship was generously established by Carol Mon Lee in memory of her husband, the late Professor Dr. Jerry H. Bentley, a renowned specialist in World History at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. Dr. Bentley was named a "Pioneer of World History" by the World History Association in 2011 and was the founding editor of the *Journal of World History*. He published extensively on the cultural history of early modern Europe and on cross-cultural interactions and exchanges in world history.

This scholarship provides for awards of up to \$5,000. For the 2021-22 academic year, three scholarships may be awarded.

### Eligibility:

- ✚ Full-time History graduate student in good standing
- ✚ Preference given to doctoral students
- ✚ Field in World History
- ✚ Funds may be used for costs of attendance or for research
- ✚ Scholarship may be renewed for total of up to two years of support; must reapply for renewal

### Application:

- ✚ Statement of academic interests and description of how funds will be utilized
- ✚ Copy of STAR academic report / transcript (unofficial OK)
- ✚ Letter of recommendation from an academic faculty member
