Duk Hee Lee Murabayashi

Biographical/Historical Notes

Mrs. Duk Hee Lee Murabayashi was born in Pyongyang, Korea on June 27, 1941. She graduated from Kyunggi Girls' High School in Seoul in 1959. She has a BA in Sociology from Womans University (Korea, 1963), MA in Sociology, University of California, Berkeley (1965), and MS in Urban and Regional Planning, University of Southern California (1968). Mrs. Murabayashi also completed the Hawaii Management Program, University of Hawaii (1985) and received the Advanced Certificate in Gerontology, University of Hawaii (1995).

Mrs. Murabayashi has retired as an urban planner after working in private consulting and research, and for the State and City governments in Hawaii for 30 years. Her professional activities have included responsibility for all aspects of land use and environmental planning from conceptual development to implementation and administration. In addition, she has directed and participated in several visitor industry-related projects, including two community development plans for Jeju Province in Korea. Mrs. Murabayashi taught a course on Environmental Impact Statements at the Jeju National University in Korea in 1998.

Her community activities range from the President of the Korean Chamber of Commerce, Korean Centennial Committee's General Vice Chair to the Hawaii Tokai International College Board of Regents, Vice Chair to the Trustee of the University of Hawaii Foundation. In 1990, Mrs. Murabayashi received a Presidential Citation from the President of the Republic of Korea for outstanding contribution to the Hawaii Korean Chamber of Commerce and received the U.S. President's (Obama) Volunteer Service Award in 2014. She was again honored to receive the Order of Civil Merit Moran Medal from the Republic of Korea in October 2019.

For the past 20 years, Mrs. Murabayashi has devoted full time to researching Korean immigration history in Hawaii and published four books, *One Hundred Years of Korean Immigration in Hawaii* (in Korean, 2003), *History of Korean Christian Church, Korean Christian Institute and Dongi Hoi* (in Korean, 2008), *Korean Experience Chronology in the United States* (in Korean and English, 2010), *A Centennial History of the Korean National Association* (in Korean, 2013), *Syngman Rhee's Thirty Years in Hawaii* (in Korean, 2015), *Traces of Dr. Syngman Rhee's Overseas Independence Movement* (in Korean, 2016, co-writer),

Story of Picture Bride Chun Yun Hee (in Korean, 2017, co-writer), and many papers both in English and Korean on the Korean immigrant history in Hawaii. In the spring semester of 2003, Mrs. Murabayashi taught "Koreans in Hawaii" at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. and continue to lecture on the subject at various universities in Korea.

Mrs. Murabayashi currently heads the Korean Immigration Research Institute in Hawaii.
