Battalion Retreat Parade

1. There will be a Battalion retreat parade at 1730 hours, Tuesday, 23 April 1946 in Piazza C. Alberto. Calls will be as follows:

First Call . - 1735  
Adjutant Call - 1740  
Retreat - 1745

2. Captain Rodarme will be Battalion Commanding Officer and will select staff and Company Commanders as desired.

3. Battalion will be composed of two companies of 144 men each to be formed by the 100th Battalion and attached company, and two companies of 144 men each to be formed by the 3rd Battalion and attached company. Color company as designated by Battalion Commanding Officer. Men not in the last parade will participate.


4. Regimental colors will be carried. Color guards to be furnished by Regimental Headquarters Company.

5. Uniform: OD trousers and shirt, Eisenhower jacket, helmet liner, combat boots, cartridge belt (stripped), M-1 rifles for rifle platoons, except BAR man, carbines for weapons platoons and company officers.

6. All requests for transportation will be submitted to Regimental S-3 by 1200 hours, 22 April 1946.

7. Regimental S-3 will arrange for the band and lay out the parade area.
