	Bug spray (and sunscreen) preferences
	Lyon Arboretum has many positive features, but it also has many mosquitoes. We strongly recommend that all visitors, especially our campers, wear bug spray AND bring the bottle with them to reapply during the day.
	Another useful strategy is for campers to wear long pants and long sleeves to reduce their exposure to the mosquitoes and to the sun. (Socks that cover the ankles are also recommended!) Determined mosquitoes can still bite through some clothing, but keeping the limbs covered does seem to reduce the number of bites overall. Mosquito repellant can also be applied over/onto the clothing.

We *strongly* recommend allowing insect repellant to be applied to head/neck/face of children in addition to their arms and legs.

Our staff is more than willing to help apply spray, and we are experienced in preventing children from getting it in their eyes, nose, or mouth.

There are also insect repellant products available such as wipes and creams that provide protection while offering more control over where the repellant is applied. (However, it is our observation that anti-mosquito bracelets, patches, and stickers seem not to be effective.)
