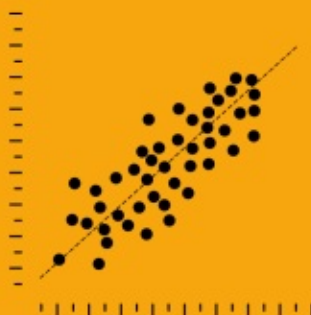
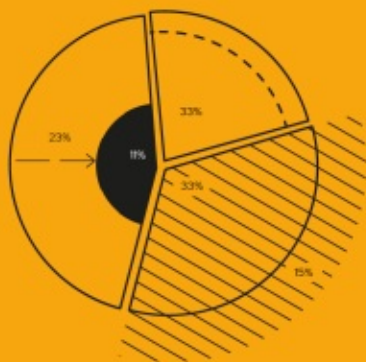

METHODOLOGY: Performances Lenses & Weightings

The QS World University Rankings® have been published since 2004. Whilst the headline measures have not changed since 2005, we introduce refinements to provide even stronger results year after year.

Academic Reputation	Taken from the QS Global Academic Reputation Survey, here we evaluate the perceptions of worldwide academics on which universities are academically excellent. 151,000 responses were used in this year's analysis.	40%
Employer Reputation	Taken from the QS Global Employer Reputation Survey, here we evaluate the perceptions of worldwide employers on which universities produce the best graduates. 99,000 responses were used in this year's analysis.	10%
Faculty Student Ratio	This is the ratio of academic staff to students. A higher number of staff:students is an indirect indicator of a university's commitment to learning and teaching.	20%
Citations per Faculty	This ratio measures the average number of citations obtained per faculty member, and is an estimate of the impact and quality of the scientific work produced by universities. This indicator is calculated using data from Scopus. To avoid anomalous results, an affiliation cap is applied discarding papers with an unusually high number of affiliations. Self-citations are excluded and citation counts are normalized, ensuring that citations achieved in each of the five broad faculty areas are weighted equally (more information: https://support.qs.com/hc/en-gb/articles/360021456540-Faculty-Area-Normalization).	20%
International Faculty Ratio	The International Faculty Index is simply based on the proportion of faculty members that are international. It is a proxy measure for how internationally attractive the university is to academic staff.	5%
International Students Ratio	Similar to the international faculty ratio, this not only serves as a proxy for how attractive the university is to international students, but how internationalised the student experience will be.	5%
Employment Outcomes	Employment Outcomes reflects the ability of institutions to ensure a high level of employability for their graduates, while also nurturing future leaders who go on to make an impact in their respective fields. For this, we have combined two metrics, widely known from our QS Graduate Employability Rankings: Graduate Employment Rate and Alumni Outcomes Index (more information: https://support.qs.com/hc/en-gb/articles/4744563188508-Employment-Outcomes-).	0%
International Research Network	IRN Index reflects the ability of institutions to diversify the geography of their international research network by establishing sustainable research partnerships with other higher education institutions. It also reflects the efficiency of this as we look at the diversity of partner locations against the efforts needed to achieve such a diversity (more information: https://support.qs.com/hc/en-gb/articles/360021865579-International-Research-Network-IRN-Index) .	0%

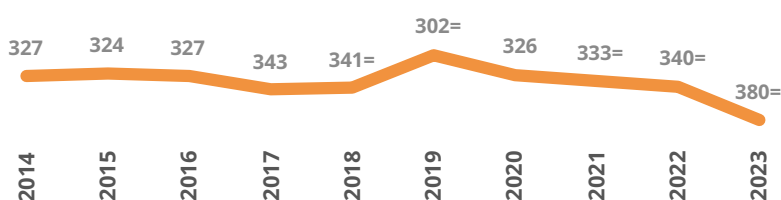

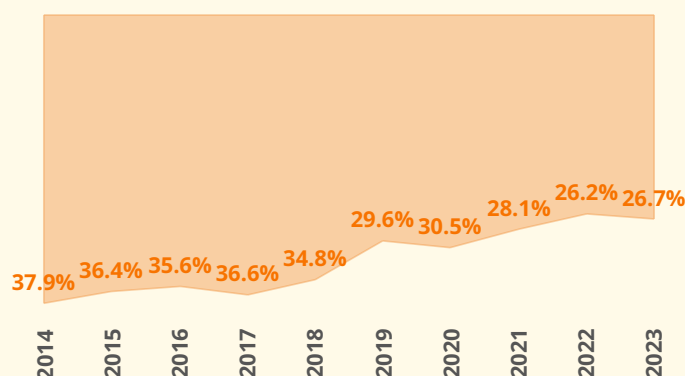


Since 2014, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa moved down 53 places. Over the 10 considered years, the institution moved up 3 times and fell 6 times.

PERCENTILE EVOLUTION QS WORLD UNIVERSITY RANKINGS



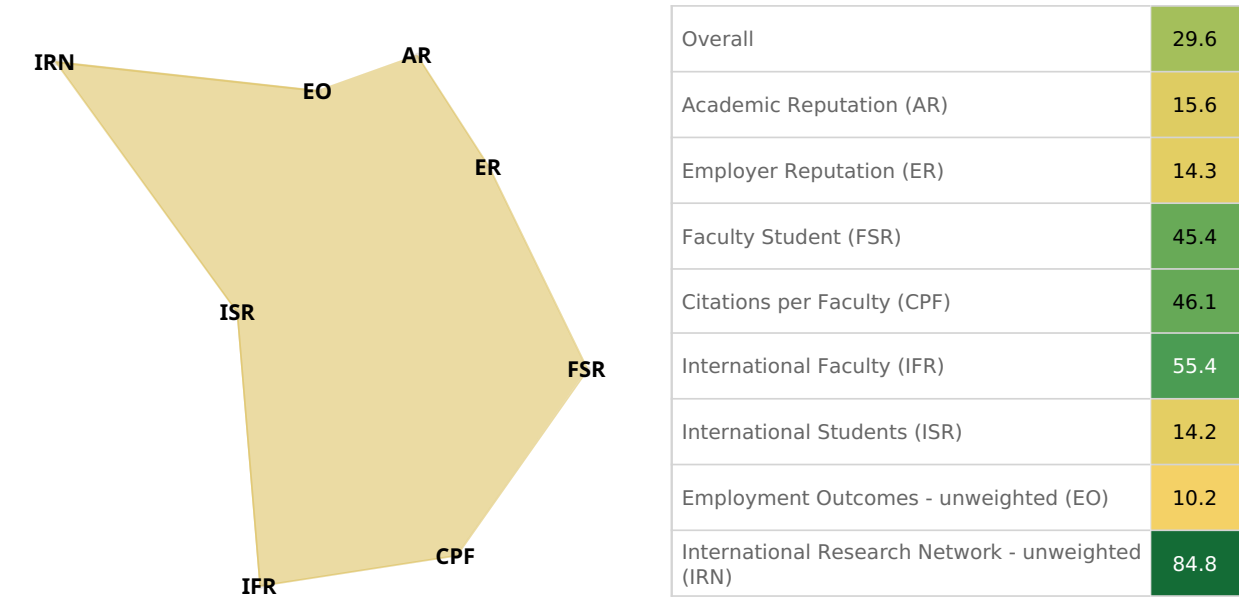

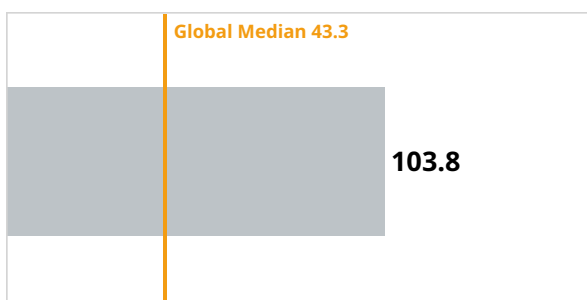

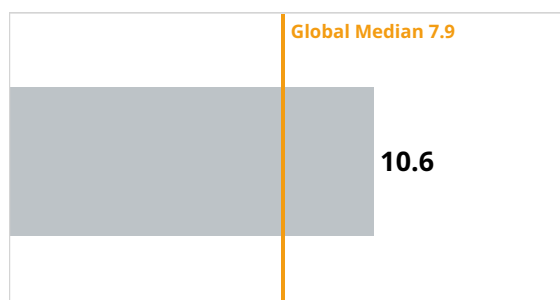
CITATIONS PER FACULTY

Normalized citations per faculty member



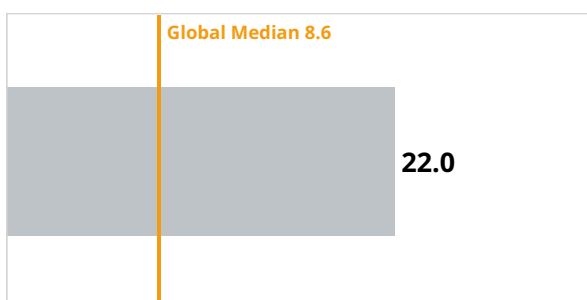
FACULTY STUDENT RATIO

Faculty staff per 100 students



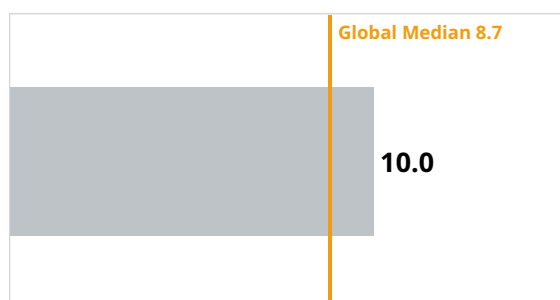
INTERNATIONAL FACULTY RATIO

International faculty staff per 100 faculty members

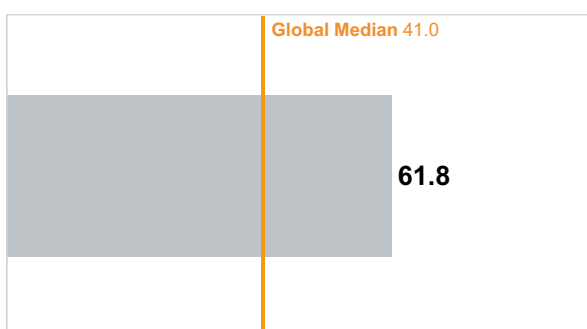


INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS RATIO

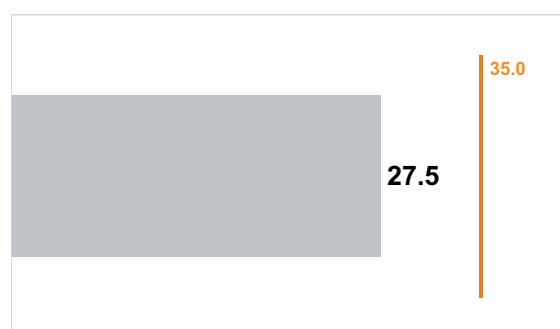
International students per 100 students

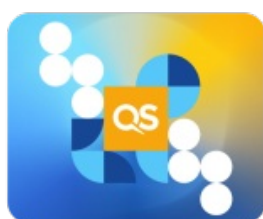

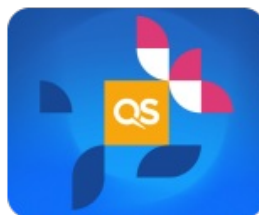
