Notes:

- * Several Dance courses are offered only once a year, or every other year; students **must** meet with their Dance advisor every semester prior to registration.
- Students must audition for acceptance into the BFA in Dance program.
- Participation in at least two (2) UH dance productions per year, with at least one in a performance capacity.
- Annual attendances at BFA Audition/End of Year Assessment Class.
- Must audition at least one piece of original choreography for concert performance as a prerequisite to the senior project by sixth semester of study.
- DNCE 3X1/4X1 signify ballet or modern dance. Minimum 45 upper division (300+ course) credits are required.
- Students must incorporate all focus requirements into this plan. Focus designations (i.e., W, E, O, H) are CRN specific & semester specific.
