## Major Requirements for Executive RN to BS in Nursing

Admission: Complete all but 9 non-nursing graduation credits at the time of application.

Application: Deadline = January 5

Min. credits: 40

Min. C grade (not C-) in all nursing courses

### Additional Program Information

- Each didactic/lecture course is offered in a 4-6 week intensive on-line format, with 2 face to face sessions per course.
- The two clinical courses span the entire semester.

**PORTFOLIO OPTION:** A portfolio can be submitted for **only** one of the courses offered with clinicals. It will be reviewed by a faculty Committee; if approved, the course is granted the credits without the need to attend the class.
