## **Hawaiian Language Elective Courses**

\*Koho 'Ōlelo Hawai'i (9 credits): HAW 345†, 373, 383†, 384, 425, 426, 427, 428, 429, 430, 435B, 435C, 445, 454, 462B, 462C, 462D,

463, 466, 470†, 483, 484, 485†, 486†, 488, 490, and 499† (Minimum of 3 credits of 499 may be counted towards the Hawaiian Language major).

Koho Pili i ka 'Ōlelo Hawai'i (Maximum 3 credits): HAW 284; MAO 102; SAM 102; TAHT 104; MUS 312, 412, 413; SLS 430; or, LING 445

Repeatable Courses: If majors choose to take a repeatable HAW course, the highest grade/credits will be counted towards the major while the lower grade and credits will only count towards their electives, NOT the major.
