Students entering public accounting should prepare to become a Certified Public Accountant (CPA). Many
students who graduate with an accounting degree are employed by national or international CPA firms, or by
local CPA accounting firms. Some open their own independent practices after they become certified.
• Must have: 150 semester hours of college education, 24 upper-division business credits, and 24 semester hours
of upper-division Accounting courses.
 Min. total credits for CPA: 150 (125 + 25 in electives or 125 + Master of Accountancy)
