- 2. Meet with an Interdisciplinary Studies advisor to begin work on a proposal.
- 3. Locate a faculty advisor in area of specialization to work together on an appropriate curriculum. Deadline for a complete, signed proposal: All acceptable, signed proposals must be submitted no later than 21 credits before planned graduation date.
- 4. Internal review by Interdisciplinary Studies Review Committee.
- 5. Accept with revision or Accept without revisions or Reject.
