 - Rated President Lassner well; Challenges for upcoming year are covid and budget. Need funding for football Ching field and removal of Mauna Kea management. Expansion of online programs esp at CCs;
 - 2. Generally pleased with the direction of UH.

 - 2. Strategic planning continues. SMS (outside group) conducting survey.
 - 3. Classification project & PIG group on faculty classifications: some faculty have productivity challenges and 5 year reviews are an issue.

 - 5. Will meet every 2nd and 4th Tuesday with goal of finalizing Charter and Bylaws in Fall and starting first meeting in Spring 2023.
 - 6. Will be sending out links to draft of Charter & Bylaws. All MSS are encouraged to review and comment suggestions.
- B. MSS Budget Ad Hoc Committee
 - 1. Sen. Leong & Sen. Simmons wanted to work on this.

- 2. Goal to determine what needs are for MSS and funds to support. Approach to speak with John Kinder on MFS to get an idea of how they request. Also working with Deb Ishii for guidance.
- 3. MSS committees should start to think of any needs and potential budget requests and send in ideas. Aim to send in final requests after September meetings.
- 4. Budget requests would be due in Oct 2022 to Provost for consideration for inclusion in budget request to BOR.
- C. Bylaw Changes Ad Hoc Working Group
 - 1. There are a lot of changes being considered and the workload is significant. A working group with additional MSS members would help on the workload.
 - 2. Sen. Leong provided MSS Shared Governance Chair with a collection of all proposed changes that have been brought up for review in the past year to start with.
 - 3. We could act to move forward with smaller and easier changes right away, and keep making progress on harder issue that require more time and may lapse into future terms.
 - 4. Large issue of note: expanding eligibility to all staff beyond just APT. Also an issue of note for the ACCSCC.

 - 1. Have heard that we will be allowed to request for a year long period this time. Will still have periodic evaluations every 3 months by supervisors.
 - 2. Approvals are being delegated down to Dean level for requests for up to 2 days telework per week. Any requests over 2 days a week would still need Provost level review and approval.
