Technical Sergeant Ryan A. Muller is the NCOIC AFROTC Instructor at Detachment 175, University of Hawaii at Manoa, HI. He oversees completing the administrative process of the cadets to ensure that they can successfully commission. He is also the AS 100 Instructor and responsible for teaching Air Force values, and integrating new cadets into the military lifestyle.

TSgt Muller enlisted into the Air Force in February of 2016. He completed his technical training as an Electrical Systems Apprentice in September of 2016 from Sheppard AFB in Texas. He was then assigned to the 36th Civil Engineering Squadron Anderson AFB, Guam. He served as an Electrical Systems Supervisor supporting the Wing's continuous bombing mission. He supported several missions including COPE NORTH, and VALIENT SHIELD. While stationed there he deployed to Saipan to support Typhoon Yutu relief where he led his team in recovery and planning operations.

He was then assigned to the 823rd RED HORSE Squadron in October of 2019 to serve as an Electrical Systems Supervisor. While there he was a Project Manager for various Troop Training Projects. He was also, NCOIC of the Ground Skills Combat Training section where he trained members to deploy to remote regions around the world. In his final year he was the NCOIC of the Electrical Systems QA section where he inspected electrical plans for the unit's project portfolio, and trained QCs for future projects. In April of 2022 he deployed to the 1st Expeditionary Civil Engineering Group where he was the craft lead and training manager in support of INHERENT RESOLVE, and SPARTAN SHIELD.
