Should you wish to take additional courses during your paralegal program or via summer enrollment you could choose from the following areas to work towards your BA requirements in preparation for transfer: FGC, DB or DP (whichever one you did not complete for your AS degree), DY, Language requirements (101-202).
- Political Science requires proficiency through the 202 level in Hawaiian or a Second language. If
 you have language proficiency you can take a placement exam and either take a higher level
 course to earn back credits or waive out of the HSL requirement.
- Once you have completed at least 12 college level credits you should consider joining the Ka'ie'ie Degree Pathway Program to assist in your planning and transition to UH Manoa. See the next page for contact information.
- The Political Science undergraduate program offers a minor, major (BA), and BA/MA Pathway.
- The combined Bachelors to Masters Degree (BAM) Pathway for highly motivated undergraduate majors who wish to complete both degrees in five years.
