Preamble

The return of indirect costs to the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa in the form of RTRF funds continues to grow. During FY-06 our faculty generated \$30,756,085 in RTRF which was largely expended this past fiscal year (FY-07) ending June 30, 2007. As is customary, after the deduction of some general expenses (e.g. RCUH) 25% of this total, less the presidential commitment for the John A. Burns School of Medicine of \$1,508,536, was kept at the level of the UH System (\$6,240,491) and 75% returned to Mānoa (\$23,007,058). Of this amount returned to Mānoa, 2/3 was returned directly to the units generating the funds. The remainder was distributed from the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate Education for research support (e.g. start-up, infrastructure, cost sharing, etc.).

Detailed on the following pages is a summary report for RTRF expenditures for FY-07. The format for this report is as requested by the Senate Executive Committee.

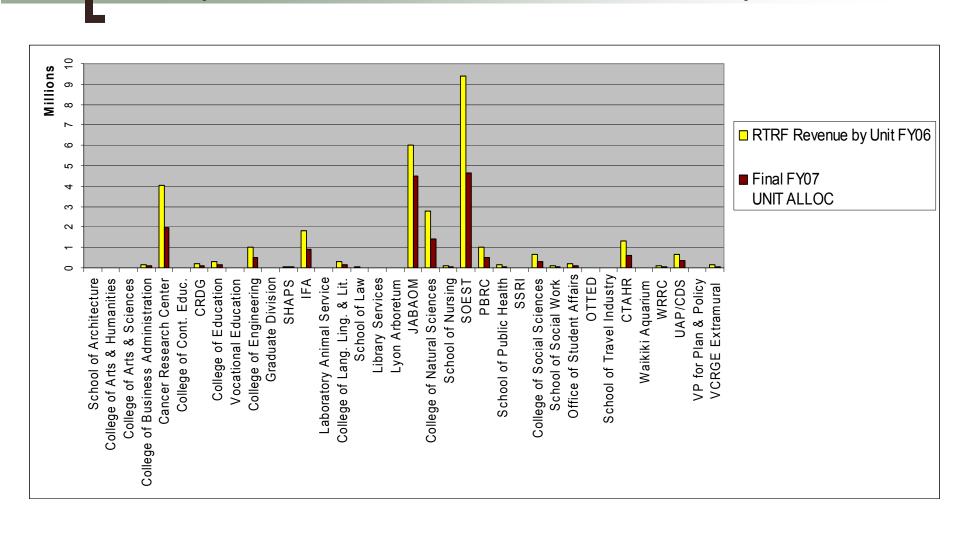
Federal funding for research has decreased. However, the University of Hawai'i continues to maintain vibrant and active research programs with approximately \$336,000,000 in research funds in FY-07. Presently, the federal funding picture is not very clear as significant federal dollars continue to flow to the war effort and the recovery efforts for Katrina. Nonetheless, the focus of the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate Education will be toward increase quality and quantity of the research/scholarship profile across the institution.

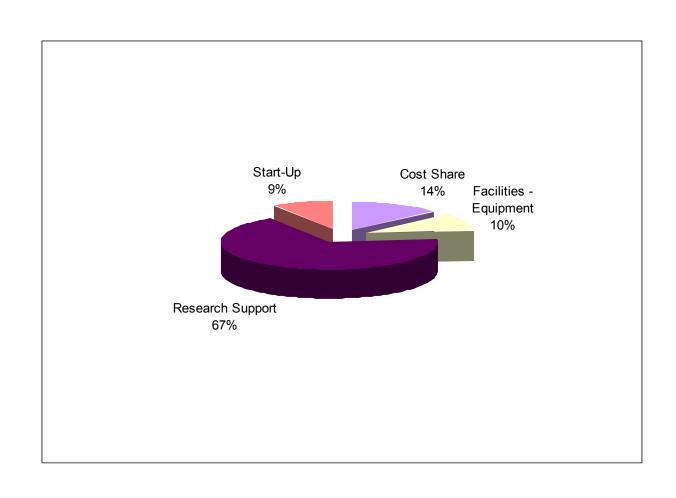

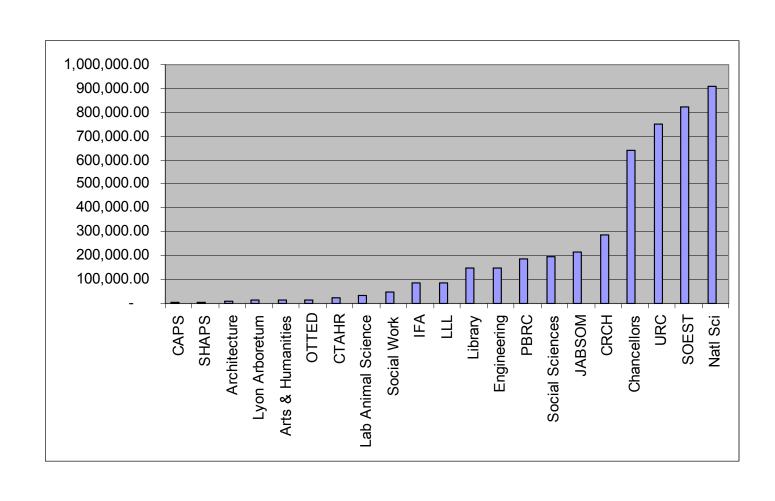

Thow were the VCRGE-RTRF funds committed in FY 2007?



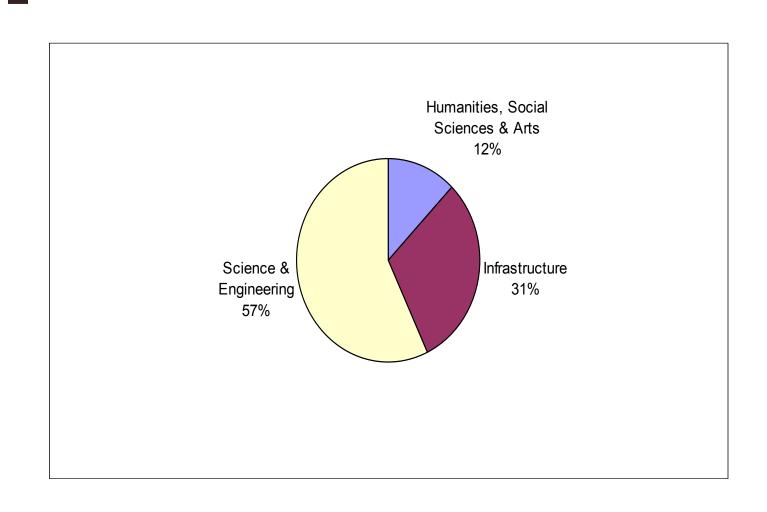
VCRGE-RTRF Commitments to the Units

What policies are currently in place for how the funds are spent within the University of Hawaii System, the UH Manoa Campus, and the Offices of our Deans and Units?

 Any extension to the award period must be approved by the VCRGE.

Any deviation in expenditure must be approved by the VCRGE. How are the funds used to support and build the research infrastructure that brought the funds into the University System?

- The VCRGE is directed to spend RTRF to support the research infrastructure of Manoa.
- A primary focus of the VCRGE is on those units that generated the funds.
- Expenditures are made in consultation with the relevant units, Deans, Directors and Faculty.

CWhat funds are projected for this year?

In FY 2007, Mānoa generated \$32,144,228.51 to be distributed in FY 2008. The return to Mānoa in FY 2008 will be approximately \$24,174,983, which includes the adjustment for C-MORE.

*How will these funds be distributed and utilized this year?

The same formula will be used for FY 2008. 2/3 of the Mānoa allocation will be distributed to the units generating the overhead revenue. 1/3 will be kept at Mānoa for research support (e.g. start-up, infrastructure, cost sharing, etc.).
