Preamble

The return of indirect costs to the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa continues to grow. During FY-08 our faculty generated \$34,279,595 in indirect overhead, a 6.25% increase from FY-07, which was largely expended this past fiscal year (FY-09) ending June 30, 2009. As is customary, after the deduction of some general expenses (e.g. RCUH) 25% of this total was kept at the level of the UH System (\$8,205,007) and 75% returned to Mānoa (\$26,074,588). Of the amount returned to Mānoa, 2/3 was directly returned to the units generating the funds. The remainder was distributed by the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate Education for research/scholarship support (e.g. start-up, infrastructure, cost sharing, etc.).

The University of Hawai'i Mānoa continues to maintain vibrant and active research programs with approximately \$328,530,935 in extramural funds in FY-09. The focus of the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate Education will be to continue to use Research and Training Revolving Fund (RTRF) toward increasing the quality and quantity of the research/scholarship across the institution.

Detailed on the following pages is a summary report for RTRF expenditures for FY-09. The format for this report is as requested by the Senate Executive Committee.



- Although in FY 2009 \$8,934,792 was available for use, \$9,833,369.02 was allocated. The difference was used against the RTRF carry forward balances.



How were the VCRGE-RTRF funds committed in FY 2009?



What policies are currently in place for how the funds are spent within the University of Hawaii System, the UH Manoa Campus, and the Offices of our Deans and Units?

 Any extension to the award period must be approved by the VCRGE.

 Any deviation in expenditure must be approved by the VCRGE. How are the funds used to support and build the research infrastructure that brought the funds into the University System?

 The VCRGE is directed to spend RTRF to support the research infrastructure of Manoa.

- A primary focus of the VCRGE is on those units that generated the funds.
- Expenditures are made in consultation with the relevant units, Deans, Directors and Faculty.

What funds are projected for this year?

In FY 2009, Mānoa generated \$37,146,710.27 to be distributed in FY 2010. The return to Mānoa in FY 2010 will be \$27,860,032.

How will these funds be distributed and utilized this year?

The same formula will be used for FY 2010. 2/3 of the Mānoa allocation will be distributed to the units generating the overhead revenue. 1/3 will be kept at Mānoa for research support (e.g. start-up, infrastructure, cost sharing, etc.). (OKAY???)
